



Information for our Guests attending Mini golf

Coronavirus (COVID-19) Updated June 12, 2020

We are very excited about re-opening Hole in Fun on June 12, 2020. We have been working diligently on new operating procedures to ensure proper physical distancing and sanitation to help protect the health of our Staff Members and our Guests the protocols below are aimed to outline our operational changes for a safe re-opening.

Please carefully consider your personal health factors when making a decision to visit us. We will be ready to serve you when you are ready to return to fun.

What to Expect Onsite

In addition to regular health and safety procedures, the following additional measures have been implemented:

Rules for Minigolf:

- Please do **not** enter if you are feeling any of the following symptoms — fever, cough and/or shortness of breath.
- Please do **not** enter if you have travelled in the last 14 days
- Please do not enter if you have had close contact with someone who has travelled in the last 14 days
- Please do not enter if you have had close contact with someone who has tested positive or presumed positive for Covid-19.
- Everyone must be from the **same household** and be a group of **6 or fewer**.

- Advance [tee time bookings](#) required.
 - Mini golf will be sold online by booking “Tee-times” this will allow us to control the flow of guests onto the courses. Tee times are spaced 10 minutes apart to allow for physical distancing between groups.
- Contactless payment is available for guests at this location. Cash will not be accepted.
- Arrive **NO MORE** than 15 minutes before your scheduled tee time
- Please park in the lower parking lot and follow the signs for the Entrance to Minigolf
 - A division has been created to control directional flow to and from the entrance to the mini golf courses.

- Queue line in front of the mini golf hut will have 2m/6f markers on ground to enforce physical distancing
- Clearly marked guidelines and paths will be visible upon arrival, always follow these to keep up physical distancing practices while on the property
- Check in with the staff member at the Mini golf Hut
 - A plexi glass barrier has been installed between the staff member and guest at point of admission
 - Clubs will have 2 bins – 1 for sanitized clubs and one for returning clubs to be sanitized by the staff member
 - Mini golf balls will have 2 clearly marked bins – 1 for returning balls to be sanitized by the staff member and one with sanitized balls which the staff member will distribute to guests
 - Hand sanitizer will be placed at the mini golf hut and throughout the course for guest use
 - Disposable gloves are available to guests should they wish to wear them.
- All touch points at point of admission will be sanitized by the staff member after each transaction.
 - Increased cleaning and sanitizing will be performed by the staff member
- Hand sanitizer will be placed throughout the course
- At each of the 36 holes there will be a plug inside to ensure guests do not have to reach their hand in to retrieve their ball
- Throughout the courses – every 3rd hole will there is a sign reminding people to stay on their course until the group in front of them is finished their round before proceeding to the next hole. Please do not try to jump ahead.
- Please ensure that all members of the group stay together at all times
- Garbage receptacles are placed throughout the course for your use.
- A limited selection of light pre-packaged snacks and drinks will be available for purchase
- All Staff have been trained in proper COVID-19 protocols
- Staff members will be wearing a mask at all times and disposable gloves as necessary
