



Information for our Guests attending On The Grand Drive-IN Events

Coronavirus (COVID-19)

The health, safety and well-being of our guests is our top priority. We are paying close attention to direction from the World Health Organization, Public Health Agency of Canada, and Waterloo Region Public Health on the specifics of the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

What to Expect Onsite

In addition to regular health and safety procedures, the following additional measures have been implemented:

- All staff involved with any guest interactions will be masked
- All event ticket purchases are done online in advance. There are no ticket sales at the gate.
- Vehicles will be spaced in accordance with provincial guidance documents, car attendants will provide direction to where vehicles are to park for the event.
- At no time can any patrons exit their vehicles unless for washroom or concession use; use of sitting in pick up beds is not permitted
- There can be no more people in any vehicle than there are seat belts
- All persons in each vehicle must be part of the same household
- The use of lawn chairs is not permitted
- Sitting in the back of a vehicle with the rear hatch up is permitted.
- Car headlights must be turned off during the events; audio will be provided via FM band transmission. Should you be concerned about accomplishing this for the duration via your vehicle, please bring a portable FM radio for use.
- Vehicle running lights are required to be turned off, otherwise you must cover them in order not to illuminate and distract others viewing of the event.
- Washrooms will be available for emergency use only. These facilities are located in our washroom building at the top of the hill. Should you need to use these facilities, please refrain from socializing with other vehicles, and move directly back and forth from the facilities. These facilities are cleaned and sanitized on a regular basis. Also, please be aware of the Region of Waterloo's new facemask policy and follow according at our venue. - Entry gates will be closed for the evening 30 min. after the start of the last performance/movie
- Advanced on line food and beverage purchases for ticket purchases are suggested for all patrons, there will be onsite purchases of food and beverage goods, collection of the pre-purchased items will be at the entry concession location for pick up after vehicles are

parked. Please remember to keep socially distance as you approach the concession, and return directly to your vehicle.

- Oversized vehicles will be directed to specific locations for parking
- At time of exit, car attendants will signal each section of vehicles when it appropriate to exit the facility. Exiting will be forwards, and thru the screen side roadway which will lead you back to Bingemans Centre Drive
- There are no in and out privileges
- We continue to monitor the situation closely and will adapt plans accordingly.
- **PLEASE NOTE, ALCOHOL IS NOT PERMITTED TO BE BROUGHT INTO THE FACILITY AT ANY TIME**

Healthy Travel Practices

Whether travelling locally or from abroad, healthy habits should be practiced at all times.
