



Information for our Guests attending a Birthday Party at FunworX

Coronavirus (COVID-19) Updated August 2021

. We are very excited about re-opening our birthday parties at FunworX! We are open and following the currently Provincial Guidelines. We have continued to work diligently on our operating procedures to ensure proper physical distancing and sanitation to help protect the health of our Staff Members and our Guests the protocols below are aimed to outline our operational changes. Please carefully consider your personal health factors when making a decision to visit us.

What to Expect Onsite

In addition to regular health and safety procedures, the following additional measures have been implemented:

Rules for entering for a birthday party:

- Please do **not** enter if you, or any of the children are feeling any of the following symptoms — fever, cough and/or shortness of breath.
- Please do **not** enter if you or any of the children have travelled in the last 14 days
- Please do not enter if you or any of the children have had close contact with someone who has travelled in the last 14 days
- Please do not enter if you or any of the children have had close contact with someone who has tested positive or presumed positive for Covid-19.

Several signs have been placed throughout the facility explaining policies and friendly reminders to maintain physical distancing. Guests and Staff Members must practice proper social distancing by standing at least 6 feet away from other groups that are not with them.

- At all entrances – Health screening signage is posted, with a QR code, which guests will answer the below questions to comply with Public Health Regulations. This will be done for all guests in the group, before being permitted further into the building.
 - Do you or any of the additional people with you have a temperature over 38 degrees Celsius?

- You will be then prompted to enter the names of all people in your group?
 - In the last 2 weeks have you or the additional people with you experienced any of these symptoms?
 - Fever, cough, runny nose, soar throat, loss of taste or smell, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, not feeling well, difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
 - In the last 14 days have you or the additional people with you been in close contact or exposed to any person suspected of or confirmed with COVID-19 without proper PPE
 - Have you or the additional people with you travelled outside of Canada within the last 14 days for reasons other than essential work?
 - Has a doctor, healthcare provider or public health unit told you or the additional people with you that they should currently be isolating (staying at home)?
 - In the last 14 days have you or the additional people with you received a COVID alert exposure notification on your/their cell? If they already went for a test and got a negative result, select NO
 - Have you or the additional people with you been living with anyone currently experiencing any new COVID-19 symptoms and/or waiting for test results after experiencing symptoms?
- At the entrance a QR code is posted which guests will scan with their mobile device to answer screening questions to comply with Public Health Regulations. This will be done for all guests, including children, in your group. Once you have answered the questions for each person attending, you must show the green checkmark to the staff person.
 - A plexi glass barrier has been installed between staff members and guests at point of admission as well as at the redemption counter.
 - Enter Only and Exit Only signs have been placed appropriately to ensure that guests do not enter and exit through the same doors where possible.
 - Hand sanitizer stations have been placed throughout the building for both guest and staff use.
 - Staff members will be wearing a mask at all times and disposable gloves as necessary
 - Guests are required to comply with [Provincial Public Health requirements](#) in enclosed public spaces. A face covering is required when in the building, including children 2 years of age and older, with the exception when eating or drinking.
 - Credit and Debit payment is encouraged, and contactless payment is available for guests at this location

Service Protocols Will Look Different:

- Candles will not be provided or permitted for the cake, as blowing out candles is not permitted.
- Prizes cannot be returned once a guest has accepted them.
- **BioProtect RTU™** has been applied to all games to protect all touch points & surfaces. BioProtect RTU™ is a water-based, antimicrobial technology that provides persistent and continuous protection of treated surfaces for up to 90 days (manufacturer's claim) this will be applied monthly.
 - Stickers have been placed on each machine to show that they have been protected.

- Increased cleaning and sanitizing of all games will be done on an ongoing basis throughout the day.
- Stickers have been placed on certain games to indicate physical distancing protocols.
- All party rooms have been thoroughly cleaned and disinfected after use
- All supplies have been removed from the party rooms and will be brought to the room when meal arrives.
- All utensils are single use and individually wrapped
- All touch points at point of admission and at the redemption counter will be sanitized by the staff member after each transaction.
- All Staff have been trained in proper COVID- 19 protocols
